KAREN PALIBRODA

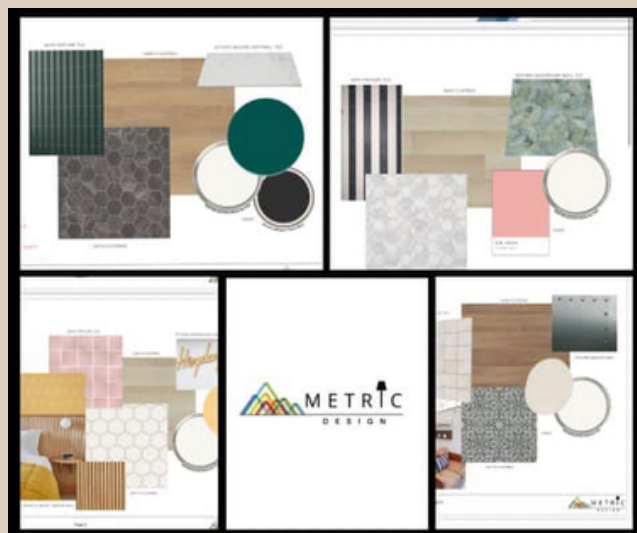
Design Associate / Princess of Pattern

When she isn't busy searching for the newest designs and looking for inspiration in colours, you can find her chasing her toddler and gallivanting in her neighbourhood.



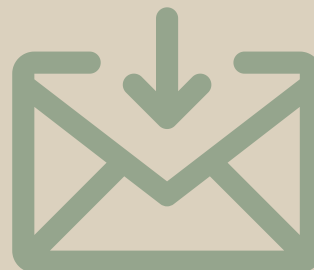
